

# Get ready to qualify for F-Gas and ODS

## LEVEL 2 AWARD IN F-GAS and ODS REGULATIONS

The UK HVAC industry has until 4th July 2011 to get its refrigerant handlers and leakage test personnel qualified to the long-awaited City & Guilds (CG) 2079 Level 2 Award in F-Gas and ODS regulations, or the CITB equivalent, which aim to improve the quality and technical competence of the engineers, while raising industry standards.

**This 2 day course certificated by City & Guilds will include:-**

**Category 1 and 11:** Leakage checking, recovery, installation, service and maintenance of equipment with a charge of 3kg (6kg if hermetically sealed) or more, of fluorinated refrigerant for Category 1 and less than 3kg for Category 11.

### Overview

- Brazes pipework, pressure tests, evacuates, recharges and commissions system
- Recovers refrigerant and completes relevant records
- Drains oil out of compressor

**Category 111:** Recovery of refrigerants (for less than 3kg of F Gas or less than 6 kg if hermetically sealed).

### Overview

- Recovers refrigerant and completes relevant records
- Drains oil out of compressor

**Category 1V:** Leakage checking of applications containing more than 3 kg or more than 6 kg if hermetically sealed of fluorinated greenhouse gases.

### Overview

- Examines pipework, visually inspects for leaks
- Uses gauges or other apparatus to indirectly determine correct charge or leakage
- Uses electronic leak detector to directly carry out leak check
- Completes relevant records



**This qualification is a legal requirement and all relevant personnel will need to take it including those who have an NVQ 2 or 3 in refrigeration or air-conditioning**
